I. Call to Order/Attendance: 10:02 a.m.

II. The Minutes from the April 15, 2026 and May 19, 2026 were reviewed and approved.

III. Old Business:

Change 357 SM – This change had been briefly discussed by the group at the May ESS meeting and was tabled to allow a more in depth review this month. The proposed additions to Part 2 were assigned the new section 203-17 and the Part 3 component to 302-17 and the Word document updated to reflect this. A suspected typo was noted in 203-17.4.1 with reference to the class and grade of *polymer* modified paving asphalt that should read *aramid fiber* modified paving asphalt. With the Surface Subcommittee's concurrence, this can be approved as noted.

The group also discussed the proposed subsection 203-17.11 Aramid Fiber Determination: The subsection identifies provisions formulae for the identification of alternative solvents to be used in conformance with ASTM D2172 in order to determine and report a percentage of extracted aramid fibers from a representative sample. No minimum amount of fiber content is provided, however, and the ESS suggests that perhaps a Certificate of Compliance from the plant stating that the AFMAC conforms with D2172 and/or the approved mix design would be sufficient for this requirement. Otherwise, an actionable result of the fiber testing would need to be specified. Colin will reach out to the Surface Subcommittee to discuss.

IV. New Business:

Change 356 UM – The change was received Tuesday afternoon from the Underground Subcommittee. The change is a minor modification to Table 306-7.3.3 to change the reference for allowable cracking on *installed* RCP from the Table 207-2.9.2 (D-Load) to ASTM C1840 Section 8.2. There is no Editorial feedback on this change, however, the ESS will table the change for approval at the July meeting in order to give members sufficient time to discuss the change within their respective organizations.
